## Surgery and Dental Consent Form

Your pet is here today for a procedure requiring anesthesia. Before administering the anesthetic, we will perform a complete physical examination of your pet. To help us ensure your pet is a low risk patient, we require a Pre-Anesthetic Blood profile to help identify pre-existing problems, which may not be evident during the physical exam. Our blood work profile includes:

- ◆ BUN (Kidney)
- ◆ Creatinine (Kidney)
- ◆ ALKP (Liver)
- ◆ ALT (Liver)
- ◆ Total Protein (Hydration)
- ◆ Glucose (Sugar)
- ◆ CBC (Red and White Blood Cells)

### Pain Medications

Pain medications are administered to all surgical patients. The cost of pain medications for elective procedures will vary from \$17.00 - \$44.00, in addition to the surgical fee, depending on the size of the patient and the medications used.

### Dental Procedures

Occasionally oral surgery is necessary due to advanced periodontal disease or severe damage to a tooth as a result of trauma or cavities. An additional fee would be incurred for these procedures. If you would like to be called to discuss any necessary extractions or repairs, please let us know now, and leave us a number where you can be reached.

### Elizabethan Collar

Some pets require wearing an Elizabethan Collar (E-collar) after surgery to prevent them from chewing or excessively licking at their surgical incision. Cost for an E-collar range between \$13.22 - \$24.04

### Permanent Identification

We can implant a microchip into your pet for an ID that can't get lost! The microchip is detected by a scanner, which identifies a unique personal number that can be traced back to you or our clinic.
