

ToeGrips are non-slip nail grips that fit onto dogs' to Enable instant traction on hard-surface floors and Stairs. ToeGrips are designed for indoor/outdoor use. They can be worn continuously, and typically need to Replaced every 1 to 3 months.

What does ToeGrips do?

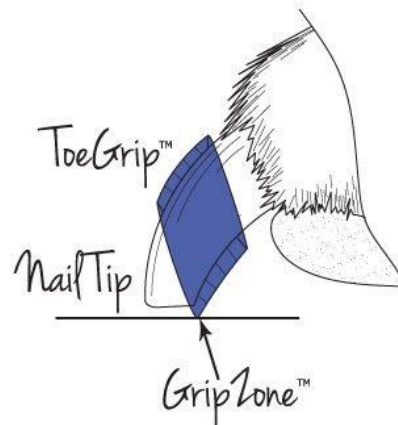
- Improve mobility & stability

Dogs use their nails for traction. They flex their paws and engage their nails like soccer cleats digging into the ground. Hard nails can't grip hard floors.

ToeGrips work by allowing the nails to grip, unlike dog socks and boots, which interfere with a dog's natural gripping. If your dog is struggling on hard floors from arthritis, injury, surgery, or disability, ToeGrips can help! ToeGrips create a "Grip Zone" where the toenail meets the floor to provide traction with every step.
